The Gwynedd Local Services Board (LSB) is led by the chief executives of the county's main public agencies. The Board provides leadership to the county, works together on specific projects, and co-operates to look for opportunities and to solve problems on a county level.

The aim is to serve the people of Gwynedd more effectively through more co-operation. The work of the LSB is based on the Gwynedd Community Strategy – which outlines the county's priorities between 2008 and 2012. The LSB is not responsible for managing individual services. It takes a wider view of the challenges facing the county, takes action and co-operates to meet the needs of the area's citizens.
