



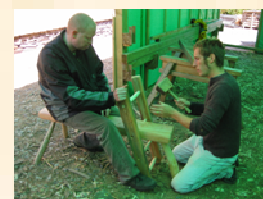
MANTELL GWYNEDD THE ENGAGEMENT GATEWAY



The Gateway is a scheme supported by funding from the European Union that aims to reduce economic inactivity in Wales and improve the employability of disadvantaged people furthest from the labour market. The aim of the Gateway is to help people make progress towards employment. The gateways will invest in organisations that provide activities to build skills, confidence and knowledge of target groups; and which link progress to a 'next-step' such as referrals to other projects, volunteering, training, supported employment or full employment. 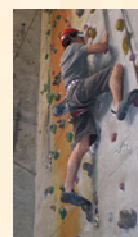
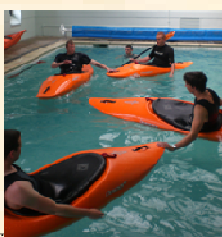
PRINCE'S TRUST
