Information: Aims and Objectives

Mantell Gwynedd, having formed a new partnership with the Sports Council for Wales, has established a pilot grant fund until the end of December 2008, to support non-sporting voluntary organisations across Gwynedd.

The Pilot Fund offers revenue grants to a maximum of £1,000 for activities that will :

- Encourage people of all ages, who do not usually take part in physical activity, to become active;
- Encourage more physical activities in the community by voluntary / community groups not traditionally associated with sport / physical activity;
- Encourage and nurture more people to be qualified sports leaders, in order to lead and run a wide range of sport / physical activity programmes;
- Contribute towards increasing fitness levels and improving general health across our communities;
- Improve and increase resources for organising sport / physical activities in the community;
- Motivate people to take part in new activities which can lead to increased self-confidence and ability.

Contact Information Who can apply for a grant?

- The fund is open to any voluntary non sporting community group, voluntary association, registered charity or local branch of a national organisation which has a constitution and works for the benefit of the people of Gwynedd,
- All activities must be located in Gwynedd. If a group / organisation works outside Gwynedd, the project / scheme must be run and held in Gwynedd;
- The group must have a bank account in the organisation's name;
- The group must understand and show commitment to equal opportunities in relation to access, language, culture, gender and racial issues.

Who cannot apply for a grant?

- The fund is not open to established sports groups / clubs e.g. football, rugby, gymnastics clubs etc. (These groups should apply to the Lottery / Gwynedd Community Chest)
- Individual members of the public;
- Primary and secondary schools;

What will the grant fund?

- A minimum of 4 sessions must be held under this scheme;
- Applications for the cost of leadership training / qualification in sports / activities, in order to organise /run sessions in the community;
- Funding to purchase equipment specifically for certain sports/ activities;
- Any costs relating to a new activity will be considered provided the applicant can demonstrate sufficient levels of interest.

The following activities / elements cannot be funded:

- Activities such as gardening, DIY, environmental improvements, dance performances, or circus skills;
- Specific activities and training fees for established sports group / club leaders e.g. football, rugby, hockey, swimming etc. (apply to the Lottery / Gwynedd Community Chest)
- One-off taster sessions;
- Projects considered a part of the daily running costs of an organisation;
- Financial support for individuals;
- Personal items of clothing;
- Permanent administration costs;
- Catering and hospitality;
- Medals, certificates or trophies;
- Home or overseas trips;
- Replacement, repair or maintenance costs for the current equipment;
- Personal Indemnity Insurance for coaches;
