Welcoming Huw to Mantell Gwynedd

Earlier this year, we were successful in our application for a grant to extend the project through the Lottery Community Fund which will fund the role for four years. In his role, Huw will provide one-to-one support to individuals who have additional support needs, and who could benefit from help to volunteer.

Originally from Caernarfon, Huw gained a degree in Welsh and History at Bangor University in 2019, before going on to work for Golwg360 and Golwg as a general reporter and later, as a parliamentary reporter in Cardiff. He took the opportunity to return to Caernarfon, and refocus his career on more local and community work in 2023 accepting a position as Community Leader with Cymunedoli Cyf.

In his spare time he is one of the directors of a company that organizes musical gigs in the Caernarfon and Bangor area. "I am really looking forward to being part of a team that promotes and facilitates volunteering across the county and helps to build communities where everyone has the opportunity to make a positive difference. I have admired the work of the Volunteering Center for a long time, and I feel very excited to start my new job with Mantell Gwynedd, an organization that is so highly respected.



The event was a huge success again this year. 


