Annual General Meeting



Mantell Gwynedd held its Annual General Meeting on 12th November in the unique surroundings of Portmeirion, bringing together partners and organisations from across Gwynedd. This year's theme was volunteering, highlighting the vital contribution volunteers make to communities and showcasing inspiring new initiatives.

The meeting opened with an update on Mantell Gwynedd's work over the past year, followed by a focus on innovative volunteering projects. **Beca Gruffydd**, from Mantell Gwynedd talked about the recently launched **Ffrindia Newydd** befriending scheme, sharing the story of how the project has begun to connect people experiencing loneliness with trained volunteer befrienders. The scheme, still in its first year, has already made a meaningful difference to individuals across the county.



Attendees also enjoyed an engaging presentation from **Luke Ryan** of the **Talylllyn Railway**, who spoke about the achievements of their Youth Member Group. Luke described how young volunteers successfully built a replica gunpowder wagon, a project funded through the Gwynedd Youth Volunteering Grant, which is administered by Mantell Gwynedd. His stories highlighted the skills, confidence, and sense of belonging that young people gain through volunteering.

The highlight of the AGM welcomed **Gretel Leeb**, Chair of the Volunteering Cross Sectoral Leadership Group, and **Aaron Fortt** from Welsh Government. They provided an update on the new **Vision for Volunteering in Wales**, outlining the national framework designed to support organisations, strengthen volunteer experiences, and increase opportunities across all communities. There was an emphasis on ensuring that the vision also takes root in every department in Welsh Government which offers a clear direction for the future of volunteering in Wales.

Mantell Gwynedd extends its thanks to all speakers, organisations and volunteers who continue to shape a vibrant third sector in Gwynedd.
