

An Overview in Numbers

- **150** local residents are expected
- **20** volunteers are expected
- Volunteers will give over **5,000** hours to help run the cafe
- Hafod Ceiri received **£98,795** of grant money in order to open a new cafe in Llithfaen

Stakeholder Engagement

Volunteers

- **2** focus groups held with volunteers
- **8** responses to the questionnaire

Residents

- **2** focus groups with the residents
- **2** one to one conversations
- **20** responses to the questionnaire

Volunteers

- **100%** of volunteers anticipate that their feeling of belonging to a community will increase
- **63%** of volunteers anticipate that their sense of purpose will increase
- **100%** of volunteers anticipate that they will feel less lonely

Residents

- **70%** of residents anticipate they will feel less lonely
- **100%** of residents anticipate that their feeling of belonging to a community will increase
- **40%** of residents anticipate that their physical health will improve
- **100%** of residents anticipate that their mental health will improve
